The Department would like to send 4 members to a high angle rope rescue class being held in Dayton. The training lasts 5 days and is being held June 17-21, 2019. The cost is \$ 500 for each person plus expenses. This was tabled until a later date.

There was discussion about working into the budget beginning 2020 the replacement two sets of turn-out gear each year.

The Department is currently out of black helmets (includes shield). There are 2 needed right now and 2 more are needed for pending new volunteers. The cost is about \$ 400 for each helmet/shield.

The department would like to update the cordless power tool set. A Milwaukee 20V set would match the batteries used for a Genesis cordless combi-tool that is planned in the future. The cost is \$ 750. Mr. Knapp will have a more definite price quote for the next meeting. This was tabled for a future date.

New Volunteer Firemen were introduced. Brady Bonham and Shawn Miller.

Mr. Keith Neale returned \$ 68.08 in cash to return monies that were incorrectly reimbursed to him for meals at the 2018 FDIC. There was a misunderstanding between Mr. Neale, Department Officers and Mrs. Weber. Mrs. Weber incorrectly reimbursed Mr. Neale for meals. The cash has been deposited back into the Special Levy Fund where the reimbursement came from.

Cody Knapp has completed a 3-day course certifying him to teach live fire training. He will be reimbursed \$ 150 for this training.

The 3 MIL Special Levy for Fire and EMS is up for renewal or replacement. Several options were discussed and a decision will be made at a future meeting. Some long-term planning needs to be established.
