	The Department would like to send 2 or 4 members to a high angle rope rescue class being held in June. The class is 5 days long and the cost is \$ 500 for each trainee plus expenses.
	The pressure washer is in need of servicing.
	The Department would like to start replacing two sets of turnout gear per year so that all members will have up to date gear. The cost is approximately \$ 2,000 per set.
	The Department would like to update their cordless power tool set with a Milwaukee 20V set to match with the batteries for a Genesis cordless combo tool. The cost is approximately \$ 750.
